MADISON: Madison Medical Clinic, 222 S. Main Street from 1:00pm – 5:00pm.

Current immunization records are required.



ELVPHD serves both Vaccines for Children (VFC) eligible and insured children. To be VFC eligible a child must either be on Nebraska Medicaid or heritage health, be uninsured, be underinsured or have health insurance that does not cover immunizations, or be American Indian/Alaskan native. There must be a parent or guardian accompanying the child to receive immunizations. If someone else brings the child to clinic, they must have a proxy form and health questionnaire filled out and signed by the parent. In addition, please bring the child's health insurance card if the child has health insurance. All forms may be found on the ELVPHD website at www.elvphd.org. There is suggested donation of \$19.50 per vaccine injection. Funds received from donations or administration fees are used to support the public immunization clinic functions. However, no one will be denied vaccinations for inability to pay.
